Rules for entry

1. Eligible applicants are high school juniors living with a parent or guardian who is a Blue Grass Energy member.
2. Applications must be submitted to Blue Grass Energy by **Monday, March 2, 2009**; late applications will not be considered.
3. All contestants will have an interview and will take a brief quiz on cooperatives at their nearest Blue Grass Energy office. Contestants will be notified of interview time after application is received. Study guides will be provided.
4. All contestants are required to write a letter of at least 300 words to one of their elected representatives on the topic of their choice. **Letters are due at the time of interviews.**
